Kai Cole-Bennett, 20, of Washington, DC

Both have been accused of multiple armed robberies throughout the region and are incarcerated on a no bond status.

Code Enforcement has also been working to identify residences placing their recyclables curbside in plastic bags. Plastic bags inhibit the processing of the recyclables and are prohibited. Town Ordinance O-4-2019 prohibits plastic bags as part of recycling whether inside or outside the recycling bin and provides for a \$50 fine for violation of the ordinance.
