National Night Out is traditionally held on the first Tuesday in August. Because of COVID-19, the 2020 National Night Out was cancelled. On August 4th, in lieu of National Night Out, officers of the Colmar Manor Police Department met virtually with members of the community to discuss community policing concerns.

During the month of August each police officer attended Implicit Bias training. The training was sponsored by the Town's insurer, Local Government Insurance Trust (LGIT). Training to help improve police / community relations will continue throughout the year.

The 2020/2021 school year with Prince George's County Public Schools began on August 31st. Due to COVID-19 classes are again being held virtually. We will be distributing school supplies in September. The COVID-19 Health Emergency has brought many changes including cancellation of most activities and reducing direct contact with the public. CODE COMPLIANCE MONTHLY REPORT

*THE FOLLOWING REFLECT THE ACTIVITY OF THE CODE COMPLIANCE OFFICE FOR

The following complaints / observations were addressed:

- 24 high grass notices issued
- 1 complaint re sump pump discharging onto private property
- 9 trash / bulk / recycle warning notices issued
- 2 open storage warning notices issued

Code Enforcement has also been working to identify residences placing their recyclables curbside in plastic bags. Plastic bags inhibit the processing of the recyclables and are prohibited. Town Ordinance O-4-2019 prohibits plastic bags as part of recycling whether inside or outside the recycling bin and provides for a \$50 fine for violation of the ordinance.

Waste Collection Days

Monday	Household Trash	Regular Trash is collected each Monday. Trash should be placed curbside in supplied containers by 6:00 am (but not before 7:00 pm the day before).
	Yard Waste	Yard waste is also collected on Mondays. Please place yard waste curbside in brown paper yard waste bags (NO PLASTIC BAGS) or in a reusable container marked with an 'X'.
Wednesday	Bulk Trash	Bulk Trash is collected each Wednesday after 6am by appointment only. Call 301-773-2069 for an appointment before 2pm Tuesday. Bulk Trash should be placed curbside by 6:00 am (but not before 7:00 pm the day before).
Friday	Recyclables	Recyclable waste is also collected on Fridays. Please have recyclable waste curbside in the container provided by 6:00 am (but not before 7:00 pm the day before) – NO PLASTIC BAGS
