Application Instructions for 2018 Elections

Can I vote by absentee ballot?

Yes, if you are a registered voter in Maryland and reside in the Town of Colmar Manor. Please ensure your address registered with the Board of Elections is in the Town of Colmar Manor. Only residents of the Town of Colmar Manor can vote in Town Elections.

How do I get an absentee ballot?

Complete and sign the absentee ballot application and return it to Town Hall by the deadline. The application must be received no later than **April 27, 2018**. The **Town Hall office closes at 5:00 p.m.** Those who will require receipt and return of ballots via US mail (e.g. students away at school or traveling residents) should have their application in no later than April 20, 2018.

How do I submit my application for an absentee ballot?

If the Town of Colmar Manor receives your completed application by the deadline, the Town will issue you an absentee ballot. **Completed absentee ballots must be received by closing of the polls (8 p.m.) on May 1, 2018.** Please contact the Town Hall if you need your ballot picked up.

Can someone help me with this form?

Yes, if you have a disability or cannot read or write. Anyone can help you, except a candidate on your ballot, your employer or an agent of your employer, or an officer or agent of your union. The person can help you with Steps 1 – 3 and must complete Step 4. If you cannot sign this form, ask the person helping you to print your name in Step 3 and write his or her initials after your name.
