CODE COMPLIANCE MONTHLY REPORT

Code Enforcement has also been working to identify residences placing their recyclables curbside in plastic bags. Plastic bags inhibit the processing of the recyclables and are prohibited. Town Ordinance O-4-2019 prohibits plastic bags as part of recycling whether inside or outside the recycling bin and provides for a \$50 fine for violation of the ordinance.

Wednesday	Bulk Trash	Bulk Trash is collected each Wednesday after 6am by appointment only. Call 301-773-2069 for an appointment before 2pm Tuesday. Bulk Trash should be placed curbside by 6:00 am (but not before 7:00 pm the day before).
Friday	Recyclables	Recyclable waste is also collected on Fridays. Please have recyclable waste curbside in the container provided by 6:00 am (but not before 7:00 pm the day before) – NO PLASTIC BAGS

2020 has been very challenging for everyone including the Town of Colmar Manor and the Colmar Manor Police Department.

The year began with staffing issues. In January, public safety staffing consisted of only a member of the Prince George’s County Police department overseeing public safety operations and a police clerk. A police chief was appointed in February. Three experienced police officers have since been hired as well as a code compliance officer (shared with the Town of Cottage City). Public safety is fully staffed.

By March, COVID -19 restrictions limited most business activities as well as Town activities. Schools remain on virtual learning, capacity limits and social distancing guidelines also remain in place. Our police officers have assisted other Town staff members with contacting our senior residents, food distribution at Town Hall as well as delivering food to homes and the homeless. We were able to have a scaled back Trunk or Treat and assist with the Town’s Toy Drive. We also had a scaled back Santa With A Badge program – five young residents were provided with \$100 gift cards and a virtual shopping experience.

There were a number of police incidents around the nation during 2020, most notably the killing of unarmed black citizens, which brought police training and community relations into the spotlight. Our general orders have been reviewed and found to be in compliance with Federal and State use-of-force guidelines. Each officer attended mandated in-service training in 2020. In addition, each officer including the Chief of Police attended explicit bias training.
